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Matti Murto (s. 1947) aloitti musiikkiopintonsa 1960-luvulla Tampereen musiikkiopistossa ja siirtyi vuonna 1970 jatkamaan opintojaan Sibelius-Akatemiassa musiikinteoria- ja sävellyslinjalla. Hän suoritti vuonna 1973 diplomin, minkä jälkeen hän jatkoi sävellysopintojaan prof. Aulis Sallisen ja myöhemmin säveltäjä Kalevi Ahon johdolla. Murto on opiskellut myös musiikkitiedettä Helsingin yliopistossa, jossa hän suoritti FL tutkinnon syksyllä 2005. Hänen tutkimustyönsä aihe käsitteli Aulis Sallisen sinfonioiden I–IV orkestrointia.

Murto otti 1980-luvulla aktiivisesti osaa moniin sävellyskilpailuihin, joista mainittakoon mm. II palkinto 1981 Kaustisella järjestetyssä valtakunnallisessa sävellyskilpailussa teoksella *Polskafantasioita Jousille*, jaettu I palkinto 1984 Juhani Heinsonen viulusävellyskilpailussa teoksella *Solitude for solo violin* ja II palkinto v. 1989 valtakunnallisessa kantelesävellyskilpailussa teoksella *Balladi ja loitsu*.

Säveltäjänä Murto edustaa tyyliä, jossa sointuisat harmoniat, runolliset melodiat sekä suomalaiseseen kansanmusiikkiin pohjautuva modaalinen tai vapaatonaalinen melodusuus ovat havaittavissa. Erityisesti jousisoittimille ja harmonikalle sävelletyt kamarimusiikkiteokset ovat viime vuosina olleet hänen tuotannostaan eniten esillä.

Revontulet, preludi orkesterille on sävelletty vuonna 1982–83 Kokkolan orkesterin tilauksesta. Teos kantaesitettiin 4.12.1983 Kokkolassa kapellimestari Paavo Raution (1924–2005) johdolla, jolle myös teos on omistettu. Hän johti teoksen myös kotikaupungissaan, Tampereen kaupunginorkesterin konsertissa. Teos on yksiosainen preludi orkesterille, joka sisältää kolme erilaista musiikillista jaksoa. Säveltäjä teki vuonna 2019 teoksesta uuden version, jossa teoksen orkestrointi on muuttunut ja kesto on pidentynyt.

Matti Murto (born in 1947) started his music studies in the 1960's at the Tampere Music Institut (later Conservatory), Finland. He continued studying music theory and composition at the Sibelius Academy in 1970. He completed a diploma in music theory under prof. Jouko Tolonen. He continued his composition studies under prof. Aulis Sallinen and composer Kalevi Aho. Murto also studied musicology at the Helsinki University, where he completed a licentiate degree in philosophy in 2005. His research interests were the orchestration of Aulis Sallinen's Symphonies I–IV .

Matti Murto participated in several composition contests in the 1980's. He won the second prize in the national competition with the work for stringed instruments called *Reel Fantasies for Strings*, divided the first prize of the Juhani Heinonen compose competition in Jyväskylä, Finland in 1984 with the work *Solitude for solo violin*. He won the second prize in a national composition contest for kantele, the Finnish national instrument, in 1989 with the work *Balladi ja loitsu*.

Characteristic to his compositions are sonorous harmonies, poetic melodies based on the Finnish folk music using free tonality. Especially his chamber music works composed for strings and accordion have been widely performed in the recent years.

The Northern Lights, *Aurora Borealis*, prelude for orchestra was composed for the Kokkola orchestra in 1982–83. Conductor Paavo Rautio (1924–2005), to whom the work is dedicated, conducted the premiere in Kokkola, Finland in December 1983 and after that also in Tampere. It is a one-movement prelude consisting three different musical sections. The composer has renewed the work in 2019.
